LONG ISLAND CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION Instructions for Applicants

The **Long Island Chapter of the New York Water Environment Association** offers each year up to three-\$1,000 scholarships. These scholarships are based on the following eligibility:

- Two are granted to relatives of members enrolled in one of the eligible related programs.
- One is granted to a non-member student enrolled in one of the eligible related programs.

1. Eligibility Requirements:

- a. Applicant must be and remain a Long Island resident during year of scholarship eligibility.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or current student enrolled at a College or University.
- c. Applicant must be enrolled in full-time engineering or environmental related program with a focus on environmental issues. Such eligible programs include but are not limited to:
 - i. Environmental Engineering
 - ii. Civil Engineering
 - iii. Chemical Engineering
 - iv Mechanical or Electrical
 - v. Hydrogeology
 - vi. Biology or Microbiology
 - vii. Environmental Sciences
 - viii. Marine Sciences
- d. Payment is made by Chapter directly to the College or University after September 1st and after acceptable copy of Bursar's receipt for attendance from an accredited institution is received.
- e. Previous scholarships winners are not eligible.

2. Application Instructions

- a. Complete both sides and sign application. Must be typed or printed neatly. All information must be supplied or application will be deemed incomplete and not eligible for the scholarship.
- b. Attach to the completed application:
 - Requested essays
 - ii. Official school transcript (copies not accepted)
 - iii. A minimum of two letters of recommendation: one must be from a teacher; the other must be from someone not related to the applicant.

3. Scholarship Payment Requirement

- a. Completed payment reimbursement application must be postmarked no later than June 1 of each year.
- b. Payment will be made during the fall of each year directly to the applicant, after receipt of the following documentation:
 - Receipt from the bursar's office that the student is registered for the upcoming year.
 - Receipt of an official school transcript for the previous years' coursework demonstrating that the student is meeting academic requirements required to receive the scholarship payment.
